An Overview



Govt. Degree College Drass was established in the year 2018 with a mission of spreading knowledge in this picturesque trans-Himalayan hamlet. We are truly indebted to the UT Ladakh administration, people of Drass, who generously offered an area of 1209 kanals & 16 marlas of land for the construction of the college, thereby, making our college the largest one in the UT Ladakh. At present, the college is functional from the Higher Secondary School, main bazar, Drass which will eventually shift to its main campus at a distance of 1.5 kms from the main market; where the construction is in full swing. Around 300 students from different backgrounds are enrolled in various streams at the college. The college at present can be proud of its academic discipline, smart classrooms, young and vibrant teaching staff, sports facilities, transport for students at a nominal rate. With compliance to the New Education Policy (NEP) GDC Drass aims to become one of the leading educational institutions in the UT Ladakh equipped with modern infrastructure, digital library, starting new skilled based vocational & certificates courses, at par laboratories, residential facilities for both staff and students, palatial playgrounds with ultra-modern sports equipment, student exchange initiatives, MoU's with reputed Universities & colleges. We at GDC Drass work with the motto of opportunity in adversity.

From the Principal Desk

Drass, also known as the "Gateway to Ladakh" is located at a height of 10,800 feet (3,300 m), and is considered to be the world's second coldest inhabited place, and this makes Government Degree College Drass



unique, highest seat of learning. We aspire to become one of the leading academic institutions not only in UT Ladakh, but also at the national and inter-national level. The College is one of the youngest academic institutions in UT Ladakh, established in 2018; being at the stage of infancy, the college has embarked on the difficult yet exciting journey towards academic recognition, reputation and legacy. I am confident that the students of this college, through rigour and hard work will not just fulfil their dreams and ambitions but also contribute to the larger pursuits of the college to emerge as a Centre of excellence in academic learning. At Present, the college is offering more than 16 Undergraduate courses. All three streams of knowledge – Science, Arts and Commerce have been introduced. The college is also in the process of planning and designing courses under NEP that includes subjects of importance especially Skills and Vocational courses. The enrolment of the college has also increased exponentially from just 42 students in2018-19 to 230 in 2022-23. We are expecting the enrolment to reach 500 by 2024 and 1000 by 2030. Infrastructure-wise, Government Degree College Drass is the Largest College in UT Ladakh with 1209.19 kanals of Land. The boundary of the campus has been demarcated and fenced in 2022. The Main campus can be divided into two zones- the Academic Zone and Residential Zone. In the Academic Zone, Lecture Block, Science Block, and Administrative Block are under construction. In the Residential Zone, two Hostels, one each for boys and girls are under construction. Besides, the residential quarter of gazetted staff is also underway. All of these constructions are expected to be completed by the end of FY 2023-24. In the current FY 2023-24, this college has proposed the construction of the Principal Quarter cum Guest House and the development of the landscape in phase wise manner. I hope that by 2025, GDC Drass will emerge as an academic hub with state-of-the-art infrastructure. We welcome all the aspiring students not only from Drass, but also from entire the UT Ladakh to join this college. We assure the parents and the students that we will not leave a single stone unturned to nurture a

progressive knowledgeable mind along with various skills sets to encounter continuous challenges of life. Here at Drass college, we live and work like a family, we pay personal attention to each and every student. Eligibility

- For Final Admission in the college, after declaration of the result, candidate should have Provisional Admission record.
- 2. Students opting for Mathematics as
- Foundation Course (Major) subject should have Mathematics in Higher Secondary.
- 3. Students opting for Life Science as Foundation Course (Major) should have Botany or Zoology or allied Science in

- Higher Secondary.
- 4. Students opting for Physical and Chemical Science as Foundation Course (Major) should have Physics or Chemistry or allied subjects in Higher Secondary.
- 5. The choice of courses will be for both 1st and 2nd Semester.
- 6. Choice of Generic courses should be different from Core and Minor courses.

Note:

Each college will reserve 10% of the intake capacity for candidates outside their catchment area.

Each section will have multiple of 80 and 120 students for Practical and Non-practical subjects respectively, depending upon the human resource and infrastructural facility of the college.

Admission and choice of courses will be based on merit to be determined on the basis of the Marks obtained by a candidate in the Qualifying Examination.

Admission Procedure:

Admission to the UG courses will start from 1st June 2023 on the provisional basis. Candidates are advised to visit the college for offline registration from 1st June to 10th June 2023.

Following the Registration, the students may contact GDC Drass of their subject choice and Counselling till their result is declared. NEP-2020 will be introduced from this year, therefore, counselling committee of the college will be available for any assistance or advice with regard to choose of courses from 5th June to 20th June 2023.

The online process of admission will be notified immediately after the declaration of 12th class result.

- Gap Affidavit: Candidates having a gap of more than one year have to submit an affidavit or undertaking duly attested by 1st class magistrate regarding his/her code of conduct and unemployment.


